






### (6) OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:-

### 8. TRUSTEES:-

(a) The number of the trustees shall not be less than two or more than seven. If the number of the TRUSTEES falls below two, the remaining TRUSTEES shall not act on behalf of the TRUST except for the purpose of filling up a vacancy as long as the number of trustee is below the minimum.

(b) The TRUSTEE for the time being will be at liberty to engage additional Trustees within the number mentioned above for such period on such terms as to retirement and reengagement as the TRUSTEES for the time being may consider proper. If any TRUSTEE died, retires, becomes unfit or incapable to act to continuing or surviving TRUSTEES or TRUTEE may appoint a TRUSTEE in place of the incapacitate TRUSTEE.

### 9. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES:-

(a) The TRUSTEES shall be at liberty at their absolute discretion to accept any property public contributions, grants, collection or donations from persons, firms, companies or government or other institutions, including foreign agencies/ institutions or foreign government, for the advancement of the object of the TRUST.

- (b) The TRUSTEES shall be entitled from time to time to open and maintained bank account in the name of the TRUST within a bank or banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to the banks and to provide for opening and operation of such account (s) by the managing TRUSTEE alone or jointly by the two or more TRUSTEE or Agents engaged by the TRUSTEES.
- banks financial institutions, persons government or other institutions, firms and companies for the purpose and the objects of the TRUST on such terms and conditions as they may think fit in the interest of the TRUST and mortgage, pledge or otherwise source all or any of the properties or investment of the TRUST as a security against such borrowings.
- TRUST property if and when acquire, in future or funds and invest the sale proceeds thereof or any other moneys being part of the TRUST fund in any manner as the TRUSTEES may from time to time think fit, within the scope of this TRUST and within the scope of law.

- (e) The TRUSTEES may lend money either with or without security.
- TRUST for sending in future for any of the objects of the TRUST in accordance with the provisions or the law including the income tax law applicable for the time being.
  - (g) The TRUSTEES may create a corpus fund out of any specific grant or donation or out of income of the TRUST and invent of the same in suitable long term investment and may out of the corpus of the TRUST spend such money or out of the sale proceeds or any part thereof appropriate such money or part thereof for all or any of the charitable objects and purpose of the TRUST.
  - (h) The Managing trustees of the TRUSTEES may engage regular part time permanent or honorary staff, if necessary and according to the requirement for managing or working of the TRUST and use the TRUST, funds for payment of the salaries, compensation expenses Etc.
  - (i) The TRUSTEES may late or hire out any movable or immovable properties belonging to the TRUST for such period and at such rent or charges and or such terms, and

conditions as the TRUSTEES in their discretion may think fit in the interest of the TRUST.

  - (n) The TRUSTEES may join, co operative or amalgamate this trust with other.
- (o) The TRUSTEES may institute, defend, adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the trust property or the trust funds.
- (p) The TRUSTEES have power to frame rules and regulations to carry out and to give effect to the objects and the purposes of the trust and /or managing the affairs of the trust and to alter and or amend the same from time to time.

The TRUSTEES may do any other thing or things which is/are-incidental and conducive to the attainment of the aims and objects or any one of them.

- (c) All matters will be decided unanimously by the managing trustees and the majority of the TRUSTEES at a meeting convened for that purpose.
- (d) Resolutions may be passed without holding meeting of the TRUSTEES by circulating in writing the proposed resolutions, which must be endorsed by the managing trustee and 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of this manner; they shall be as valid and effectual as resolutions passed at a meeting of the TRUSTEES.
- (e) The TRUSTEES shall keep or cause to be kept a minute book of the proceedings of the meetings.

Government Department, public or persons, schemes and other works and matters with the alms proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
